## DESIGNATION OF PRINCIPAL/SUBSIDIARY CAMPAIGN COMMITTEES

A candidate may designate one political committee as his principal campaign committee. A candidate may also designate one or more political committees as his subsidiary committees. Further, a principal campaign committee may designate subsidiary committees. Any designated committee must file a Statement of Organization and submit a \$100 filling fee. The use of principal or subsidiary committees is entirely optional. If committees are used, this report must be filed no later than 10 days after the designation is made. If a committee is organized to support a single candidate and that candidate refuses to designate that committee as his principal or subsidiary committee, he must file a statement, in writing, disavowing the committee. Once such a disavowal is filed, no funds may be exchanged between the candidate
